» PROJECT DETAILS

When Monarch Hospital was in need of a renovation, they saw it as an opportunity to create an innovative space that could expand with the hospital's changing needs. The 24,000 SF building needed to be designed in a way that could accommodate private offices, collaborative areas, conference rooms and a system of cubicles. However, it was important to keep in mind that everything needed to be done in a cost-effective manner.

After taking into consideration the size of the space, all the requirements of the hospital staff, and cost efficiencies, designers saw that the entire space could be re-designed for less than \$15 per SF using EQA's high end MaiSpace furniture system. The new plan was outfitted with systems furniture, private office suites, conference tables, zone cabling, integration of both collaborative spaces and private office, employees were given the chance to freely interact or perform concentrative work.
